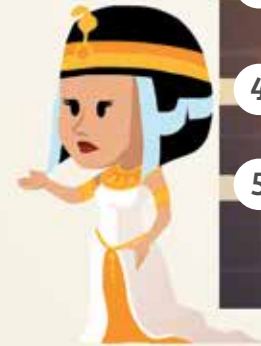


Facts about

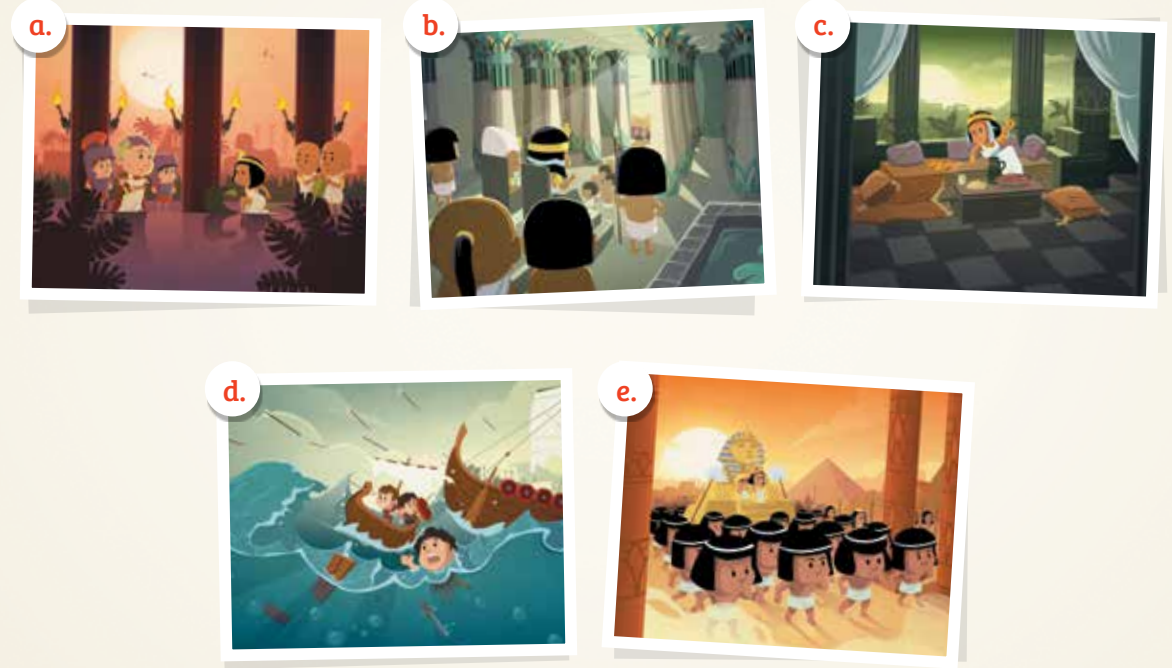
